Some response categories have also been grouped where small numbers could risk identifying individuals.

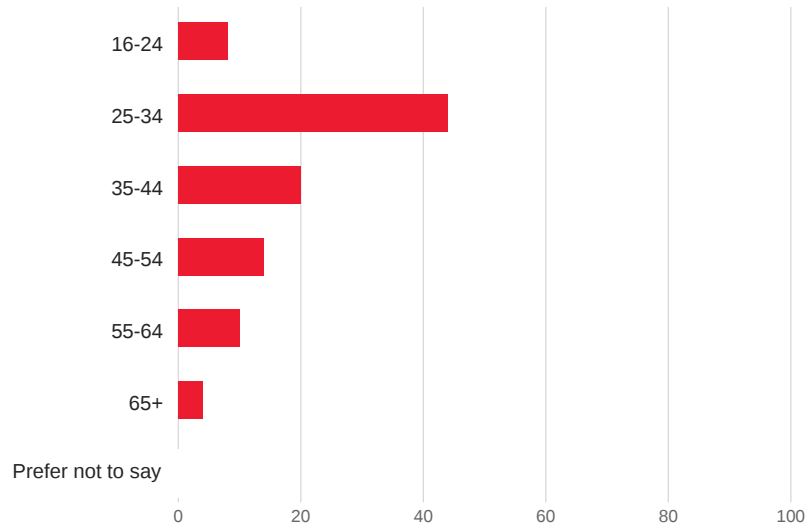
For example, on the religion question, **Jewish, Muslim, Sikh, Buddhist, Other** responses are grouped together.

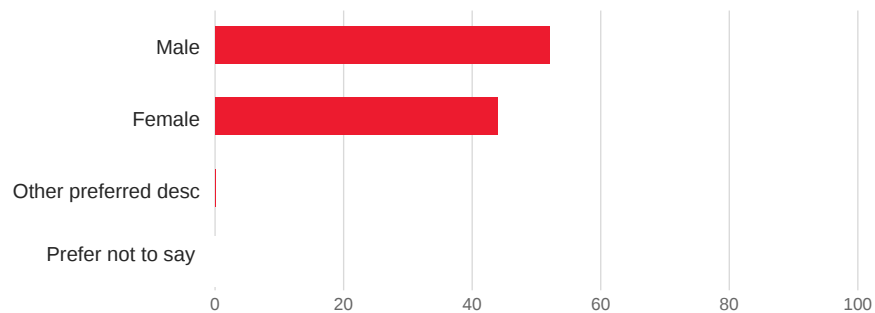

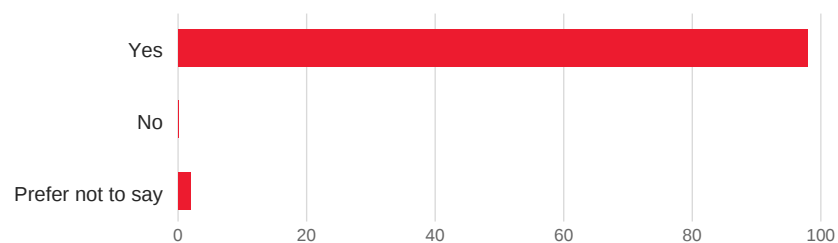

Gender Identity as at birth?

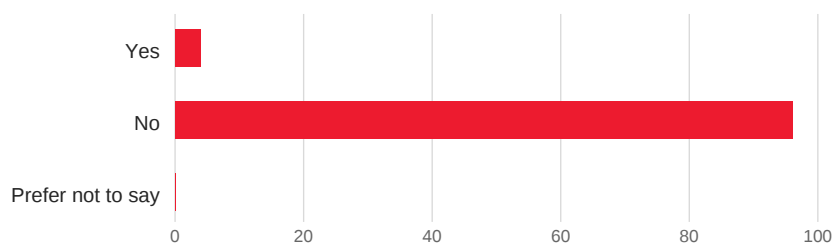

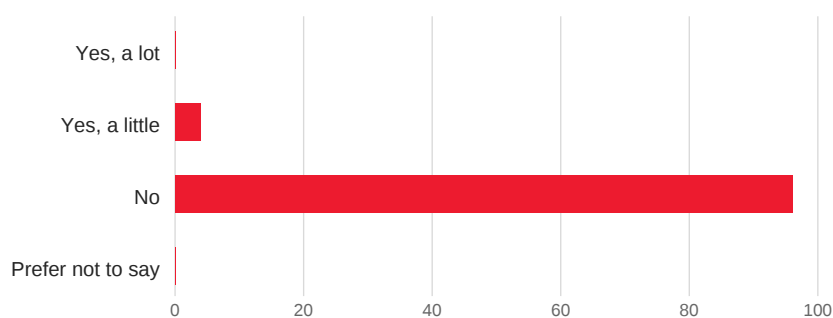

Disability according to the Equality Act, day-to-day activity and ethnic group

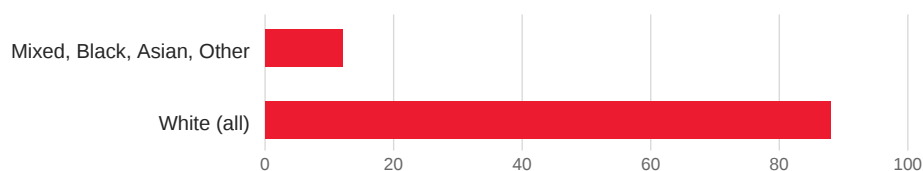
Disability according to Equality Act

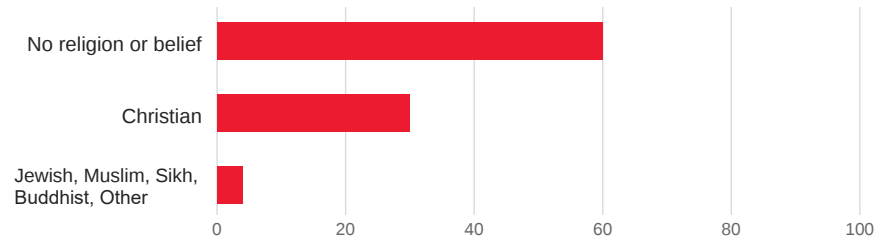

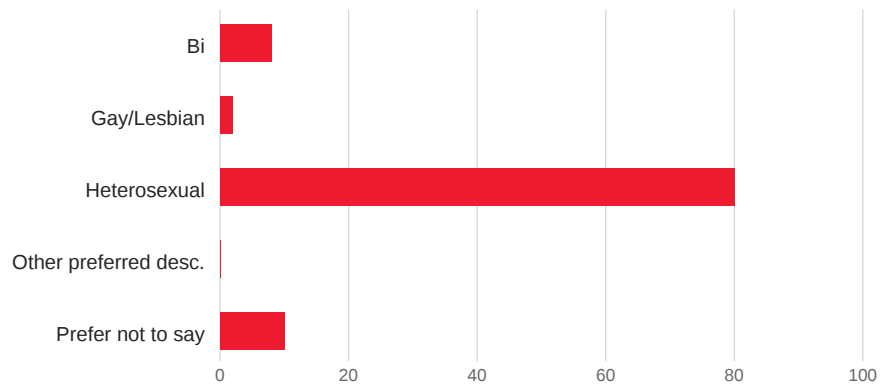

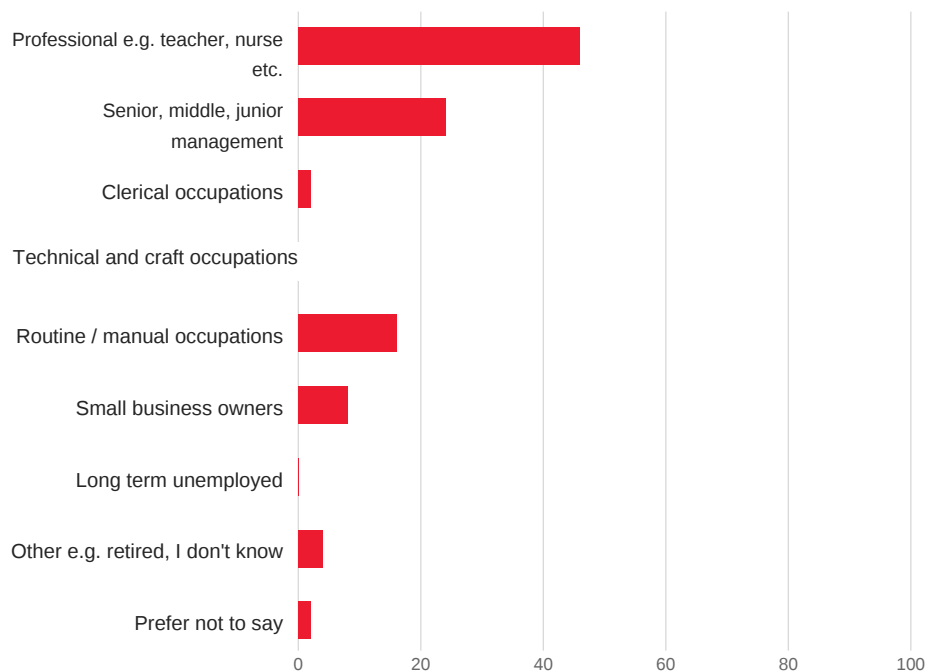

Occupation of main household when you were about 14

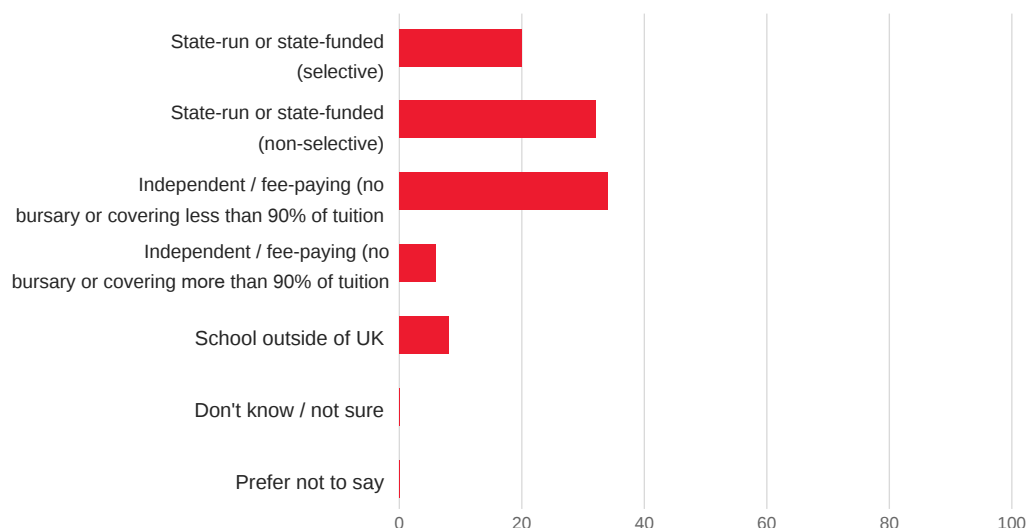

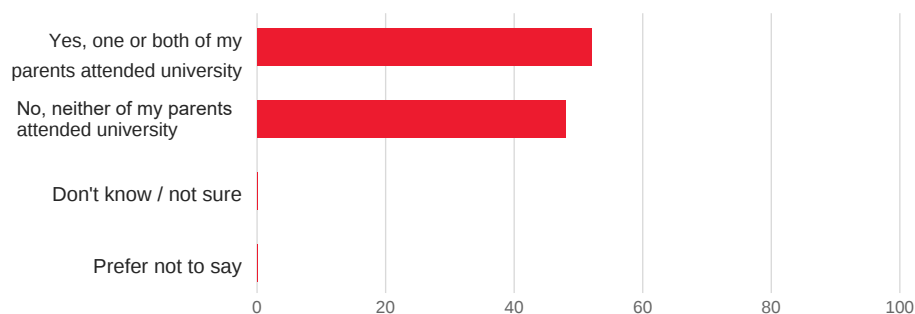

Parental education

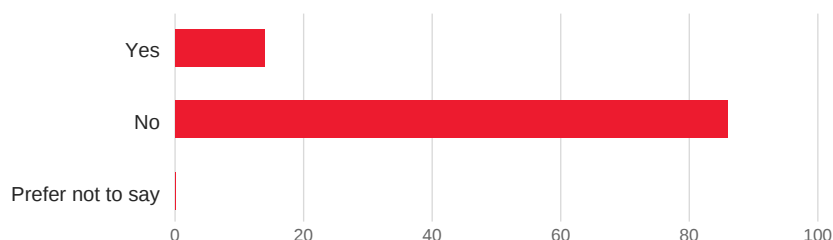
Did either parent attend university and gain a degree by time you were 18?
